

K.U.K. COMMON ARMY HUNGARIAN REGIMENTS BEFORE 1908

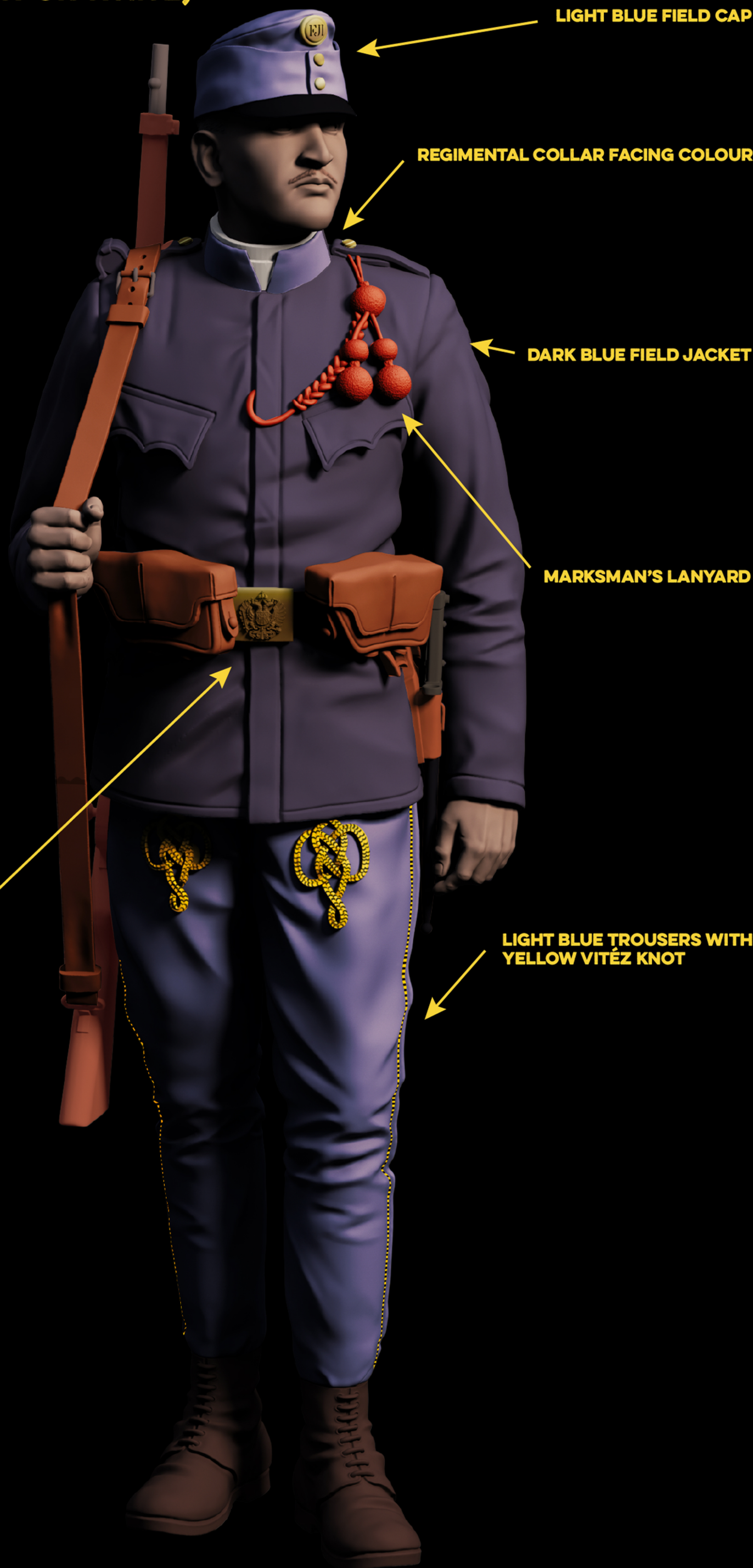
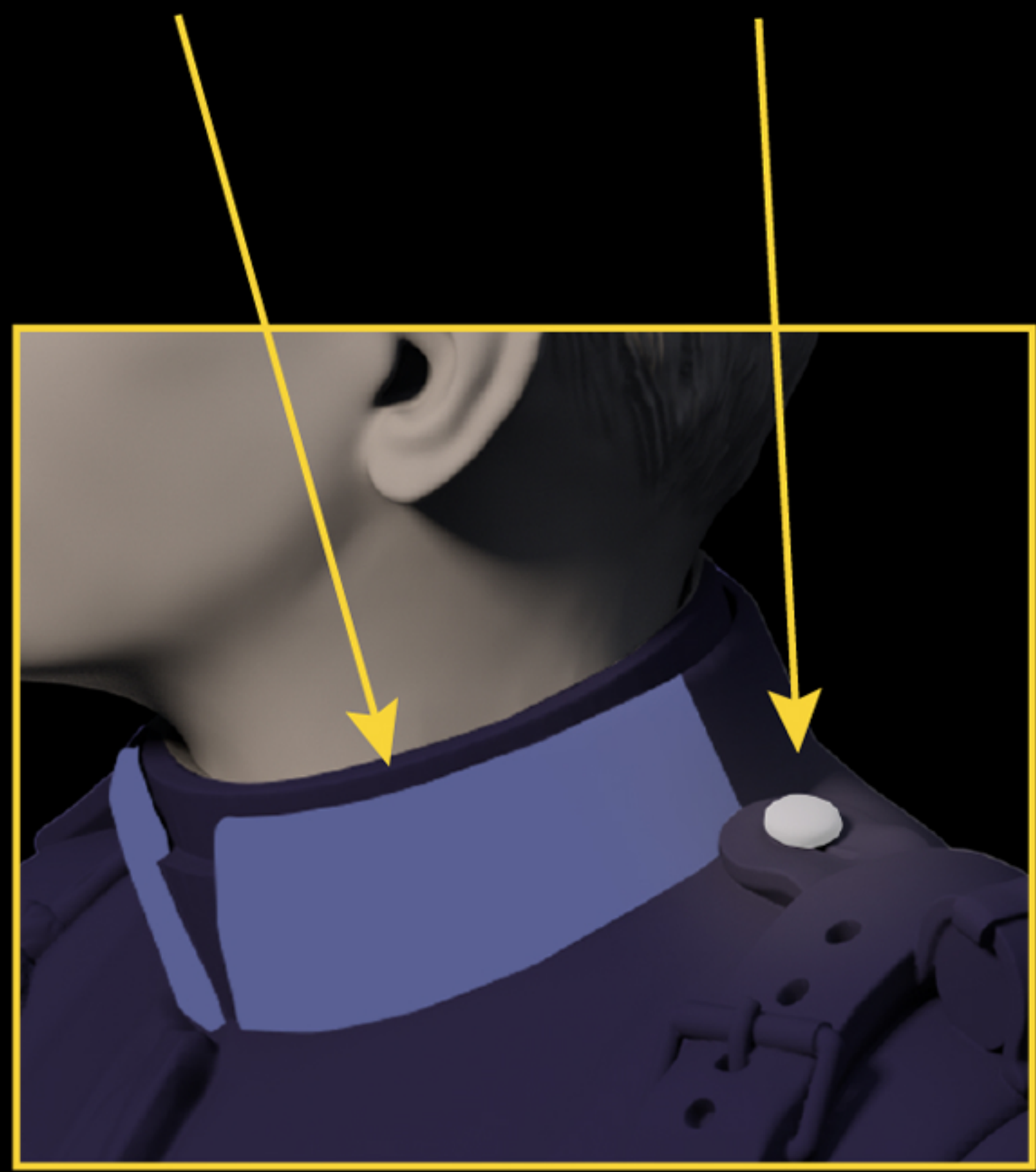
THE MAIN DIFFERENCE IN THE UNIFORMS BETWEEN HUNGARIAN AND GERMAN REGIMENTS WAS THE USE OF DIFFERENT TROUSERS. HUNGARIAN REGIMENTS WORE THE TIGHTER HUNGARIAN TROUSERS WITH DECORATIVE VITÉZ KNOT IN YELLOW AND BLACK COLOURS.

A REGIMENT CAN BE RECOGNIZED BY:  
-COLOUR OF THE COLLAR (BLUE, RED, GREEN, GREY, YELLOW ETC.)  
-AND THE COLOUR OF THE BUTTONS (YELLOW OR WHITE)

BEFORE 1909 THE LEATHER EQUIPMENTS WERE BLACKENED.

ALMOST EVERY COLOUR WAS IN USE BY 2 REGIMENTS WITH DIFFERENT BUTTON COLOUR.  
FOR EXAMPLE:

SKY BLUE COLLAR + YELLOW BUTTONS = IR NR. 32  
SKY BLUE COLLAR + WHITE BUTTONS = IR NR. 19



K.U. HONVÉD REGIMENTS BEFORE 1908

HONVÉD REGIMENTS WORE DARK BLUE FIELD CAP WITH YELLOW BUTTONS

FACING COLOUR IS RED FOR ALL HONVÉD REGIMENTS
